Dust Control Program: Discussion of applying dust control to cover entire road rather than sections. It was decided to move forward with new recommendations.

Comments from the Public: Vince from 2229 Riverwalk Drive questioned the Berrien County Road Commission not stepping up to take care of the roads. Vince also added Indiana charges a fine for noxious weeds.
